1. Call to Order and Roll Call

- Meeting called to order at 10:00 AM by Chair Edward Gamble
- Chairman Gamble stated the media was notified.
- Roll call by Secretary Killman
- Members present: Chairman Edward Gamble, Vice Chairman Brian Magaw, Secretary Andrea Killman, Kathryn Turbeville, LaNette Samuels Cooper, Michael Streath, Mary Jo Ardis. Mattie Johnson not present
- Quorum confirmed.

2. Invocation and Pledge

- Invocation led by Vice Chair Brian Magaw
- Pledge led by Michael Streath

3. Approval of Agenda

- Motion to approve agenda, motioned Vice Chairman Magaw, seconded by Secretary Killman. Carried unanimously.

4. CONVENE AS BOARD OF CANVASSERS FOR THE TOWN OF TURBEVILLE NOV 4, 2025 MUNICIPAL ELECTION

- Motion to convene as Board of Canvassers by Mr. Streath, seconded by Ms. Cooper. Carried unanimously.

- Motion to nominate Edward Gamble as Chairman and Andrea Killman as Secretary of the Board of Canvassers made by Mr. Streath, seconded by Ms. Cooper. Carried unanimously.

-Chairman Gamble administered the Oath to the Board of Canvassers. Secretary Killman then administered the Oath to Chairman Gamble. Except for Mrs. Turbeville all members of the Board of Canvassers signed the Oath.

-Chairman Gamble introduced Randy Curtis and Tiffany Smith from the South Carolina State Election Commission. Mr. Curtis spoke about the Town of Turbeville municipal election held on November 4, 2025. Mr. Curtis stated:

- There were no challenges.
- There were no Absentee Ballots which arrived late.
- The Hand Count Audit had been reviewed.
- The Polling Place reconciliation had been reviewed.
- The Early Voting Reconciliation had been reviewed.

- Mr. Curtis reported to the Board:

- There were no failsafe/challenged Provisional ballots.
- There were no UOCAVA ballots.
- There were 5 provisional ballots at the polling site. Mr. Curtis recommended the Board of Canvassers approve the 5 provisional ballots. Motion was made to count the 5 provisional votes by Secretary Killman, seconded by Mr. Streath. Chairman Gamble, Vice Chairman Magaw, Secretary Killman, Ms. Cooper, Mrs. Ardis and Mr. Streath voted in favor. Mrs. Turbeville voted against.

- The Board of Canvassers and members of the public observed Mr. Curtis and Ms. Smith insert the provisional ballots into the Tabulator. One ballot was not accepted by the Tabulator because it wasn't properly marked. Mr. Streath, Mrs. Ardis, and Mr. Curtis duplicated the "unreadable" Provisional ballot using the proper procedure. Mr. Curtis then inserted the duplicated provisional ballot into the Tabulator. The duplicate ballot was accepted and the votes were properly counted by the Tabulator.

- Chairman Gamble read the official count of votes of The Town of Turbeville General Election

- A motion to certify the results for the election was made by Ms. Cooper, seconded by Mr. Streath. Chairman Gamble, Vice Chairman Magaw, Secretary Killman, Ms. Cooper, Mrs. Ardis and Mr. Streath voted to in favor. Mrs. Turbeville voted against.

-Chairman Gamble stated the election is certified.

5. Adjournment of Board of Canvassers meeting.

-Motion to adjourn the Board of Canvassers meeting and return to Board of Voter Registration and Elections of Clarendon County meeting by Mrs. Ardis, seconded by Ms. Cooper. Motion Carried unanimously.
